## Envelope Flip Album



You can use any size envelope, it can be any colour. You will need 2
You can use any pattern paper. You will need some coordinating card to create pockets

## $5 \times 7$ album

Firstly the envelopes for a $5 \times 7$ card are slightly bigger than the 5 " $\times 7$ " card they come with so to make layers for your envelope album you will need

6 pieces of pattern paper measuring $5 \times 6-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
To make each pocket you will need
A piece of card measuring 2-1/2" $\times 6-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and a paper layer measuring $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
The smaller pocket is made from a piece of card measuring $5^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
To decorate the pointed envelope flap you will need two pieces of pattern paper cut to $6-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ and you will glue in place and trim to fit if you have the rectangle envelope flap you can use a slightly narrower strip of paper

## $6 \times 6$ Album

For $6 \times 6$ cards the envelopes are $6 \times 6$ inches
So you will need
6 pieces of pattern paper measuring $5-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
To make each pocket you will need
A piece of card measuring $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and a paper layer measuring 2-3/4" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
The smaller pocket is made from a piece of card measuring $5-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
To decorate the a pointed envelope flap you will need two pieces of pattern paper cut to $6^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and you will glue in place and trim to fit

## C6 or $4 \times 6$ Album

For $6 \times 4$ it is a bit more tricky as there are quite a few cards sold as $C 6$ however they do vary in size.

So whatever your envelope size you need to take a 1/4" off each side for your paper layer size

So my C6 envelope measures $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ so I will need 6 pieces of pattern paper measuring $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$

Hope that makes sense. Please ask if you need help BEFORE session! Step 1


Trim a smidge off both envelopes on the right side and then again on the left side approx. $1 / 16^{\text {th }}$

## Step 2

Open the cut envelopes. You will now have two long pieces


## Step 3

Put glue on the pointed flap and glue the two enveloped together shown in picture as Trim the end flap as shown by solid black line Add a score line in front of the existing envelope flap closure approx. $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ inch wide to create a gusset


You now have the basic folder shape for your journal. It's time to decorate!
