

## Envelope Flip Album



You can use any size envelope, it can be any colour. You will need 2

You can use any pattern paper. You will need some coordinating card to create pockets

### 5 x 7 album

Firstly the envelopes for a 5 x 7 card are slightly bigger than the 5" x 7" card they come with so to make layers for your envelope album you will need

6 pieces of pattern paper measuring 5 x 6-3/4"

To make each pocket you will need

A piece of card measuring 2-1/2" x 6-3/4" and a paper layer measuring 2-1/4" x 6-1/2"

The smaller pocket is made from a piece of card measuring 5" x 2"

To decorate the pointed envelope flap you will need two pieces of pattern paper cut to 6-3/4" x 3 and you will glue in place and trim to fit if you have the rectangle envelope flap you can use a slightly narrower strip of paper

### 6 x 6 Album

For 6 x 6 cards the envelopes are 6 x 6 inches

So you will need

6 pieces of pattern paper measuring 5-3/4" x 5-3/4"

To make each pocket you will need

A piece of card measuring 3" x 5-3/4" and a paper layer measuring 2-3/4" x 5-1/2"

The smaller pocket is made from a piece of card measuring 5-3/4" x 2"

To decorate the a pointed envelope flap you will need two pieces of pattern paper cut to 6" x 3-1/4" and you will glue in place and trim to fit

## C6 or 4 x 6 Album

For 6 x 4 it is a bit more tricky as there are quite a few cards sold as C6 however they do vary in size.

So whatever your envelope size you need to take a 1/4" off each side for your paper layer size

So my C6 envelope measures 4-1/2" x 6-1/4" so I will need 6 pieces of pattern paper measuring 4-1/4" x 6"

### Step 1

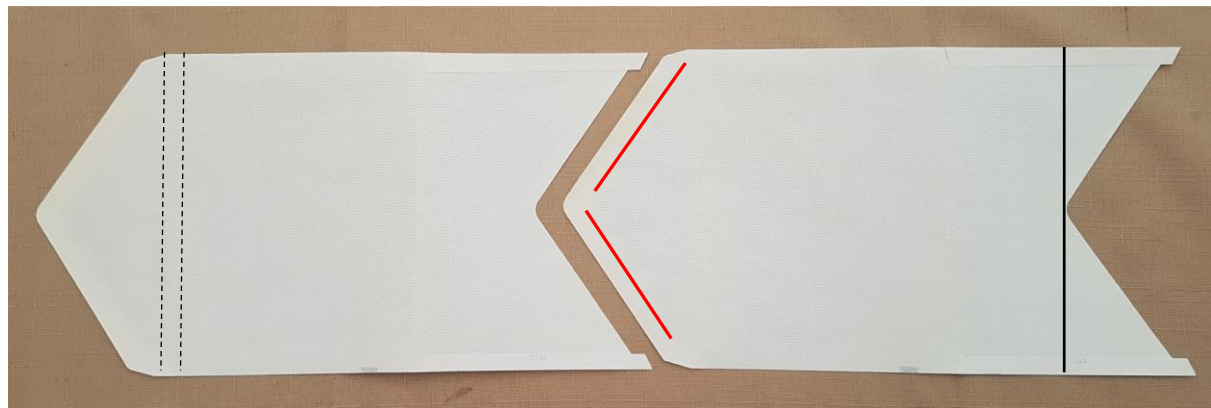


Trim a smidge off both envelopes on the right side and then again on the left side approx. 1/16<sup>th</sup>



### Step 2

Open the cut envelopes. You will now have two long pieces

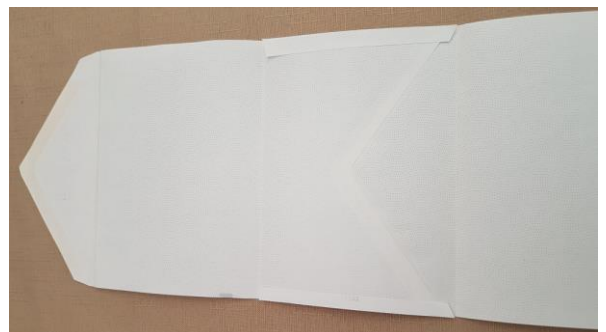


### Step 3

Put glue on the pointed flap and glue the two envelopes together shown in picture as 

Trim the end flap as shown by solid black line

Add a score line in front of the existing envelope flap closure approx. 1/8" inch wide to create a gusset



You now have the basic folder shape for your journal. It's time to decorate!
