

Stitched Frame Aperture Card



1. Cut an A4 sheet of Flirty Flamingo card stock in half length wise 4-1/8" x 11-3/4"
2. On the long side (11-3/4") score at 4-3/4", 5-1/4", 5-3/4", 10-1/2", 11, 11-1/2"
3. Next fold and burnish first score line ONLY at 4-3/4" to create card front, this will enable you to see where you need to cut out aperture
4. Centre stitched circle framelit on card front and use Big Shot to cut out aperture
5. Create a frame for the circle aperture using the same framelit and the larger circle framelit together through the Big Shot with So Saffron card
6. On the card front use the embossing folder to create a pattern along the side and bottom of the card front
7. Fold and burnish remaining score lines using a bone folder to create accordion style folds to make the sides of the card
8. Use adhesive on the last and smallest panel, to glue frame closed
9. Cut out large circle framelit using White card to put inside the card
 - a. Stamp with Happy Birthday sentiment
 - b. Stamp around the edge with large and small flowers
 - c. Glue circle inside the card
10. Stamp three large flowers on So Saffron card and fussy cut each one then cover with clear Wink of Stella. Glue to card front using foam pads
11. Add gems to each of the embossed flower centres
