

Waterfall Album Instructions



Measurements

Front Cover - a piece of Night of Navy card stock 11-1/2" x 4"

Paper layer 5-1/2" x 3-3/4"

Front square is Night of Navy 3"x3" layered with Very Vanilla 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

For the mechanism - Very Vanilla cardstock 2" x 10-1/2"
- scored at 2", 2-1/2", 3" and 3-1/2"

For the flaps Very Vanilla cardstock, 4 pieces

3-1/2" x 3-1/2" layer with DSP 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

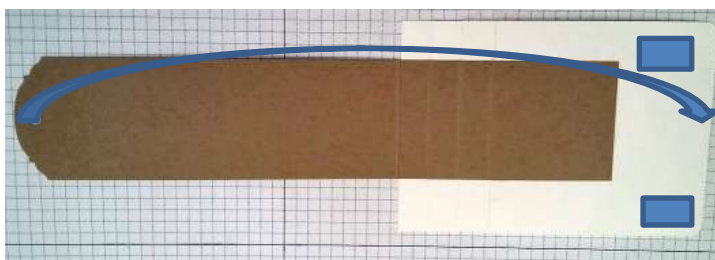
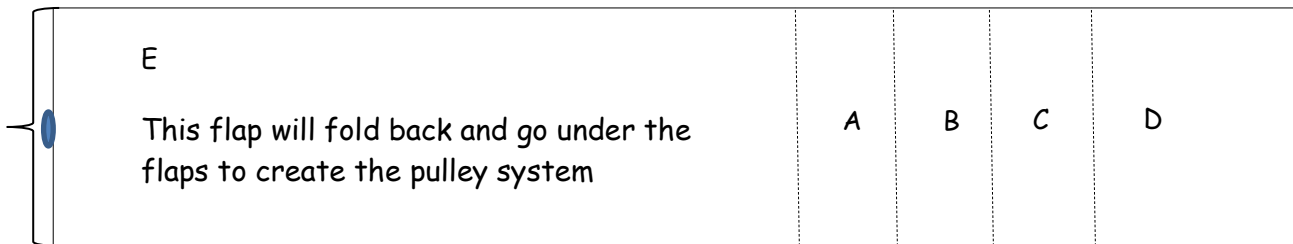
Scallop Topper Punch to create tab on pulley mechanism

Inside Pocket Very Vanilla 5" x 2" layered with DSP 4-3/4" x 1-3/4"

To attach flaps to the mechanism strip

Apply glue to section A,B,C and D only (I used strong double sided tape)

Starting with the first square attach it in place, lining it up to the score line in the D section. Allow equal overhang, top and bottom. Continue with all four flaps layering one in each section (A,B,C,D) so they are overlapping to create waterfall album



Apply glue as shown and then fold long tab over. Place downwards and glue in place, inside album using the two glue areas only. The pulley system will now work.



Add inside pocket to left hand side by gluing card strip first leaving top open for journaling cards. Layer with pattern paper
