


## Yummy In My Tummy Pop Up

This matchbox can be used as a gift card holder or for other gifts and treats



To make the spring you will need two pieces of DSP measuring 12" x 1"

1. Apply a spot of glue to one end of paper and then glue both pieces at a right angle
2. Then fold piece A over piece B and then fold piece B up and over Piece A. Continue this pattern until there is no longer enough paper to fold. Glue ends and trim to neaten off  
You can make the springs from smaller, thinner pieces of paper or wider depending on project and what you need to attach to the spring.



### To make springy Monster

1. Stamp Yummy Monster on Crumb Cake card using Soft Suede ink and fussy cut
2. Glue spring on back of monster in the centre, this will be glued to base of the match box
3. Decorate monster using the 'Hugs' stamp and use punches or dies to layer on Glimmer card

### To make the base of the match box - You will need the Envelope Punch Board

1. Use a sheet of DSP or card measuring 8" x 8"
2. Place the paper in the envelope punch board and punch and score at 2 -3/4" then move the paper to the 3 -1/2" mark and punch and score
3. Now turn the paper and using the score lines you have made, line up and punch and score a on the remaining three sides. You should have two score lines and two notches punched out on all sides
4. Fold and burnish all score lines then create another fold manually, to create the re-enforced sides for the box
5. You can create a thumb notch at this stage by folding one of the short ends, place into the punch board, folded, lining up the first score line to the 1 -5/8" line, then punch only
6. You can now assemble the base of box by creating tabs and gluing in place
7. To neaten the box, if you wish you can add a base piece

### To make sleeve

1. Measure a piece of card or paper at 5 -7/8" x 8 -1/2"
2. Score on the long side at 1/2", 4 -1/8", 4 -5/8", 8 -1/4"
3. Fold and burnish score lines then glue to create sleeve
4. Decorate sleeve as required
